#### WHAT ARE WE WORKING ON THIS WEEK IN CLASS?

- 1. **ELA:** This week, students will be reading a story pulled from the book "Tales our Abuelitas told us" by Alma Flor Ada. It's a lovely story about a bird who learns the value of friendship and kindness. Our grammar focus this week is nouns. We will also begin our first novel student of the year as well as our first writer's workshop project. How exciting!!
- 2. **Math:** This week, students will dive right into math with place value! We will be looking at how numbers are structured, the values of different numbers based on their place value position, and more! We are also beginning to practice our multiplication facts starting with the 2's.
- 3. **Science:** This Monday we began our first Science unit of the year titled *Birth of Rocks*. We learned about volcanoes and where they are located on the globe. Ask your child tonight to tell you about our lab and the "ring of fire" they mapped in class!
- 4. **Social Studies:** Tomorrow marks our first Social Studies lesson! I'm excited for our first unit of study about California's regions. This week, we will learn about where California is located on the Earth. We will even get to do a little mapping practice using chocolate chips! Yum!
- **5. Homework:** Each day this week, your child will be coming home with about 30-40 minutes of homework plus 20 minutes of nightly reading. Homework includes the following: Completing a spelling activity from the spelling menu, completing a math worksheet or assignment, completing an ELA page from the ELA packet and reading for 20 minutes. Please initial your child's planner nightly after reviewing that he/she has completed their homework assignments.
