## WHAT ARE WE WORKING ON THIS WEEK IN CLASS?

- 1. **ELA:** This week, students will read a story called Fiona's Lace from our ELA anthology. This selection is about an Irish family who immigrates to the United States in the early 1900's and faces many challenges. Students will focus on editing run-on sentences for this week's grammar skill.
