## Animal/Plant Project

This week, we will pause our studies in our ELA anthology to focus instead on our plant/animal research projects for Clem Miller. Students have already begun creating their Science boards in class, and so far, they look AMAZING! The goal is to have students get close to finishing (or finish) their board prior to the February break so that they can focus on the presentation portion when they return.

Students will also begin a plant project after break, becoming an expert on a plant that grows in and around Point Reyes. They will talk about their plant once we come across it on the trail! It's so much fun to learn plant facts, its uses, etc from the kids while we are out hiking.

Because of this weeks Science focus (in addition to our field trip and Valentine's Day), there will be no ELA packet this week.

## WHAT ARE WE WORKING ON THIS WEEK IN CLASS?

1. ELA: This week, students pause their ELA anthology studies to focus on Science.
2. Math: Students will wrap up chapter 8 (it was a short chapter) and will start to look at how fractions relate to decimals.
3. Science: This week, students will continue their animal research project based on an animal that lives in Point Reyes (where Clem Miller is located). They have research guidelines to follow, are working with a partner, focusing on presentation requirements and more. Student will share their poster boards that they create out at the education center!
4. Social Studies: This week, we will continue to focus on C.A. when it was a part of Mexico
5. Homework: Read 20 Minutes-Finish Book Report Outline
