WHAT ARE WE WORKING ON THIS WEEK IN CLASS?

- 1. **ELA:** This week, students will finish up their amazing inquiry projects to share with their peers on Friday. We will begin a new unit (unit 2 lesson 1) in Language Arts that focuses on amazing scientists and scientific discoveries next week.
- 2. **Math:** This week, students will spend Monday and Tuesday on their chapter 2 practice test. On Wednesday, we will do a jeopardy review in class, which we will follow with the chapter 2 test. I can't wait to celebrate the amazing progress students have made with multiplication over the past few weeks.
- 3. **Science:** Next week, we will begin a new unit all about the human body. The lesson and lab next Monday looks at how muscles control our bones to move our bodies. We will be making a finger model and exploring tendons, bones, and biceps! How cool!
- 4. **Social Studies:** This week, students will look at climate in our four California Regions. Once we conclude our studies, students will work with a team to create a regional weather report! They'll write scripts, wear costumes, and even work on an online set! They're very excited!
- **5. Homework:** This week, students will be working on their math review test at home, reading for 20 minutes, as well as working on reading their book report books and outlines. Also, parents should be checking over student bikes to ensure they are in good, working condition. Check chains, breaks, handlebars, etc.
